



FLEA TREATMENTS

To ensure an effective and safe treatment please read these simple do's and don'ts before treatment commences.

DO'S

- Vacuum rooms to be treated before our arrival and dispose of the contents to the rubbish bin.
- Remove all small items off the floor and in particular all children's toys.
- Securely cover all indoor fish tanks (any air pumps should also be turned off on our arrival).
- Remove all other pets from rooms to be treated.
- Ensure all cats and dogs are treated for fleas to prevent re-infestation.

DON'TS

- Re-enter treated rooms until the spray is dry. We recommend that you always leave a minimum of 2 hours. Laminate or wooden floors take longer to dry so we suggest you allow a minimum of 4 hours where these are present.
- Vacuum treated areas for at least 2 weeks.

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Not all fleas will be killed immediately. The treatment uses chemicals that remain active, so please wait a few days before calling us if you are concerned that fleas are still present.
- Heavy infestations may require an additional treatment 2-4 weeks later for which an additional charge will be made. This will usually be half the cost of the initial treatment charge.
