<u>TOPIC - PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER - UPPER MOORS ROAD AND ST VIGOR WAY, COLDEN COMMON</u>

SUMMARY

- It is proposed to introduce 'No waiting at any time' waiting restrictions in Upper Moors Road and St Vigor Way and to introduce 'No stopping at any time' on the existing school zig-zag markings to provide better visibility outside Colden Common Primary School and allow the school zig-zag markings to be enforced.
- The introduction of the parking restrictions has been requested by the school via one of the school governors as part of a safer routes to school scheme.
 This has also included work by the school to improve the pedestrian access for the children on to the school premises.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management and road safety.
- No objections to the proposal as advertised were received.
