SUMMARY

The allocation of grants from the Community Chest funding scheme from the approved budget. Grants to organisations which are active in areas covered by the Healthy and Inclusive Communities Portfolio have been discussed with the Portfolio Holder and the proposed decisions meet with his agreement.

DECISION

That the following grants be awarded from the Community Chest scheme:

- 1. Bishops Waltham Guide Association £250 Funding towards disability access improvements to current premises.
- Denmead War Memorial Hall £250 Funding towards storage facilities for the youth activities taking place at the Hall as problems relating to a lack of storage have been identified.
- Jubilee Rovers Junior Football Club £265 Funding towards new training equipment for the football club which has over 70 young people involved.
- Soberton Village Hall £336 Funding for replacement curtains in the main hall as the current curtains are over 20 years old.

- 5. Swanmore Village Hall £447 Funding to enable the marking of car park spaces (including disabled parking slots) at the Hall to enable improved access for the community bus and disabled access vehicles.
- 6. TAdance £250 Funding towards set up costs for this new dance group at the Tower Arts Centre (and

including outreach) for disabled and mobility impaired people.

Grants from the Community Chest scheme are made quarterly. All applications for grants were considered by the relevant Portfolio Holder who received advice from the Partnership and External Funding Officer and the Director of Community Services.
