SUMMARY

The Community Safety Partnership has been allocated the sum of £14,600 as grant funding from Hampshire County Council. The criteria outlined for expenditure included the delivery of local initiatives that will have a positive impact on the wider Hampshire priorities.

A letter has been sent to the County Executive Group outlining the planned expenditure for Winchester and that was accepted and funding formally agreed on the 9 June 2011.

The CSP plan to use the funding to deliver on the following local crime & disorder priorities:

PHD356 Ward(s): General

- Reducing Violence Against the Person with a focus on the Night-time Economy and Domestic Violence
- Reducing ASB with a focus on rowdy and nuisance behaviour
- Reducing Adult re-offending and first time entrant to the youth justice system

Delivery on crime and disorder issues holds a statutory duty for local authorities.

PROPOSED DECISION

That the Portfolio Holder for Communities, Safety and Public Health support the proposed expenditure of £14,600 (funding allocation) for the delivery of the CSP priorities 2011/12 (see appendix 1).

REASON FOR THE PROPOSED DECISION AND OTHER ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

The County Council is the beneficiary of an overall amount of Government Community Safety Funding for 2011/12. They have agreed to passport a proportion of those funds to Districts and Boroughs across Hampshire for use in the delivery of priorities that contribute to the Hampshire wide crime and disorder targets. In line with Government commitments, this funding is not ring-fenced. However, any decision to use it for other purposes would mean the Winchester Partnership would be unable to deliver initiatives which will assist in achieving the Winchester and County crime reduction targets. It will also harm partnership working in this area.

RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS:

The relevant budgets for Income and for Expenditure to be increased in 2011/12 by £14,600.
