## TOPIC – TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – FROMOND ROAD, WINCHESTER

## <u>SUMMARY</u>

- Following the consultation carried out in Weeke during February 2011, it is proposed to make the existing advisory disabled parking bays in Fromond Road, Winchester enforceable.
- During the formal consultation period it was established that the two bays nearest Stoney Lane were no longer required. These bays have been deleted from the proposal and the markings will be removed.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment and for encouraging inclusive communities.

- No objections were received in response to the proposal, however, during the formal consultation period it was established that the two bays nearest Stoney Lane were no longer required. These bays have been deleted from the proposal and the markings will be removed.
- Copy of original plan showing the location of the proposal, schedule and statement of reasons are attached. (Appendix 1)
- Copy of revised plan, schedule and statement of reasons are attached. (Appendix 2)

## DECISION

- It is recommended to introduce 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' restrictions in Fromond Road, Winchester as detailed in the revised schedule attached. (Appendix 2)
- 2. That the Head of Legal Services be authorised to make the necessary order.

## REASON FOR THE DECISION AND OTHER ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

All schemes included within the draft programme and other requests received have been assessed against criteria which include road safety, the concerns of the police, Ward Councillors and the Community.

## **RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS:**

- The cost of implementing the traffic regulation order and any associated signs and lining work is covered by the Traffic Management agreement with Hampshire County Council.
- Enforcement of any new restrictions will be carried out within existing budgets.

## **CONSULTATION UNDERTAKEN ON THE DECISION**

- The proposed introduction of enforceable disabled bays was as a result of an area-wide consultation on possible changes to waiting restrictions in the Weeke area of Winchester.
- Following this consent to proceed to formal advertisement was sent to all local Ward Members, the County Councillor, Police and WCC Parking Office Manager.
- Proposal notices were subsequently placed in the Mid Hants Observer and posted on street accordingly. (Appendix 3)
- All residents in the vicinity of the proposal were notified by letter to inform them of the proposal and to establish whether the disabled bays were still required.




