TOPIC – TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – BURNETT CLOSE, WINCHESTER

SUMMARY

- It is proposed to introduce additional 'No waiting at any time' restrictions in the narrow section of Burnett Close, Winchester.
- Motorists currently parking in this location cause obstructions to either the footway or carriageway and sometimes both, resulting in access problems and potential road safety hazards for other road users and pedestrians.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- No objections were received in response to the proposal. However, five letters were received asking for the restrictions to be extended to include the wider

section of Burnett Close and the junction of Ruffield Close. One letter fully supporting the proposal was also received.

- Although there was support for the restrictions to be extended this is not possible as part of the current proposal as this would make the restrictions more onerous than advertised, which is not permitted within the legislation.
- In addition to the legal implications, to extend the restrictions further than proposed is not considered necessary on traffic management grounds and would potentially displace vehicles to other less suitable locations. The effect of the new restrictions will be suitably monitored if they are approved and implemented.
- Copy of plan showing the location of the proposal is attached. (Appendix 1)
- Copy of schedule and a statement of reasons as recommended are attached. (Appendix 2)

DECISION

- That 'No waiting at any time' restrictions in Burnett Close, Winchester be introduced, as advertised, in accordance with the plan at Appendix 1 of this decision, and the Schedule at Appendix 2.
- That the Head of Legal Services be authorised to make the necessary traffic regulation order.

RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS:

• The cost of the proposal will be funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There are no additional enforcement costs.

CONSULTATION UNDERTAKEN ON THE DECISION

• All residents of the Weeke area were consulted on the possible introduction of additional waiting restrictions in the area. The response from residents of Burnett Close showed that there was sufficient support for new restrictions in their road to be pursued.

- Draft proposals were subsequently produced and consent to proceed to formal advertisement was sent to the local Ward Members, the County Councillor and Police.
- Proposal notices were subsequently placed in the Mid Hants Observer and posted on street accordingly (Appendix 3).
- All residents in the vicinity of the proposal were also letter dropped with full details of the proposal.
