Any person aggrieved by the Statement of Community Involvement may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the Statement is not within the appropriate power or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. The application must be made not later than the end of the period of 6 weeks starting on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2007.

Any person aggrieved by the Statement of Community Involvement may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for Judicial Review of the decision to adopt this Statement of community Involvement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from 25<sup>th</sup> January 2007.
