TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – WEST END TERRACE, WINCHESTER.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for tree felling to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED: WEST END TERRACE, WINCHESTER from its junction with Romsey Road and its junction with South View.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the southern point of the closure east via Romsey Road, north-east via Clifton Terrace, north-west via St Paul's Hill, south-west via Elm Road, south-west via Avenue Road, south-east via Cheriton Road **to the northern point of the closure.**

From the northern point of the closure north-west via Cheriton Road, north-east via Avenue Road, north-east via Elm Road, south-east via St Paul's Hill, south-west via Clifton Terrace, west via Romsey Road **to the southern point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 18th November 2007 for three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 1 day)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
