#### **SUMMARY**

- In response to complaints regarding inconsiderate and potentially illegal and dangerous parking at the entrance to Marnhull Rise, Winchester it was proposed to introduce 'no waiting at any time' double yellow line restrictions in the vicinity of its junction with Sarum Road to ensure clear and safe access.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2013. Notices were
  posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in
  the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in
  the City Office reception. No responses were received.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.

- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no discernable additional enforcement costs.
