<u>SUMMARY</u>

- Due to the complaints regarding illegal parking combined with difficulties enforcing the single yellow line restrictions in Romsey Road, Winchester adjacent to the Hospital Out Patients department due to ambiguous road markings it was proposed to change the existing restrictions to create an area of short-term 20 minutes limited waiting parking bays. This would resolve the above issues and provide a useful increase in short-term parking for hospital users whilst having no impact on traffic movements.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 13th November 2013. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in

the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City Office reception.

- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- Only one response was received commenting on the proposal, which objected to the proposals due to the potential impact on disabled drivers' ability to park at this location. In reality this area is not currently available for use by disabled blue badge holders as it used by other motorists and the proposed restrictions will ensure a higher turn-over of parked cars and thereby increase the likelihood of spaces being available for blue badge holders.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no discernable additional enforcement costs.



Dear Sirs,

I would like to object to your proposed scheme for Romsey Road.

The current situation is that the area is covered by a single yellow line, which means that between 8am and 6pm only vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons badge can park here for a period limited to 3 hours.

Most days many disabled people take advantage of this and disabled people often park her for short periods while visiting the hospital, the lay-by accommodates about 8 vehicles.

This bay is a vital resource for many disabled people.

The proposal you have made would mean that these spaces currently only available to the disabled would be shared with all drivers; which would be a disadvantage for disabled drivers.

A further disadvantage and a knock-on effect is that if you make it more difficult for disabled people to park in this area; they are of course entitled to park on both single and double yellow lines for a period of up to 3 hours. In Romsey Road after 6PM when the single yellow lines are not in force many vehicle park on the single yellow lines and it causes problems to the traffic in this busy road. The effect of limiting disabled parking is likely to cause disabled people to park on these single yellow line and double yellow lines during the day time and this is likely to cause traffic problems.

The final problem with your proposal is that making the bay into a limited waiting bay has the opposite effect for disabled drivers. By making the bay into a limited waiting bay; you would be increasing the amount of time a disabled driver could park here from 3 hours to unlimited. This will likely mean that instead of allowing more people to park in the bay it with be full of disabled badge holders who because of your change are entitled to park there all day.

I urge you to reconsider you proposal to address these important issues.
