SUMMARY

- In response to continued requests from residents regarding problems caused by commuter parking in St Johns Road, Winchester and in conjunction with consultation on parking and waiting issues in Winnall as a whole, the Council consulted on the possible introduction of a new residents permit parking. The majority of residents who replied were in support of the new restrictions which were consequently taken forward formally.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 11th December 2013. Notices were
 posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in
 the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in
 the City Office reception. One response was received in support of the proposal.

- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no discernable additional enforcement costs.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal is attached (Appendix 1).
- Copy of proposed schedule and statement of reasons is attached (Appendix 2).
- Copy of the proposal notice is attached (Appendix 3).
- Copy of the advertised order is attached (Appendix 4).

PROPOSED DECISION


- The cost of advertising and implementing the traffic regulation order is covered by the Traffic Management agreement with Hampshire County Council.
