#### **SUMMARY**

- In response to complaints from residents and local Members regarding obstructions caused by vehicles parking in Sun Lane, Alresford it was proposed to adjust the existing 'no waiting at any time' double yellow line restrictions to stop parking in the area in question whilst maintaining the existing number of parking spaces.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2013. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City Office reception. One response was received which was resolved.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.

- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no discernable additional enforcement costs.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal is attached (Appendix 1).
- Copy of proposed schedule and statement of reasons is attached (Appendix 2).
- Copy of the proposal notice is attached (Appendix 3).
- Copy of the advertised order is attached (Appendix 4).

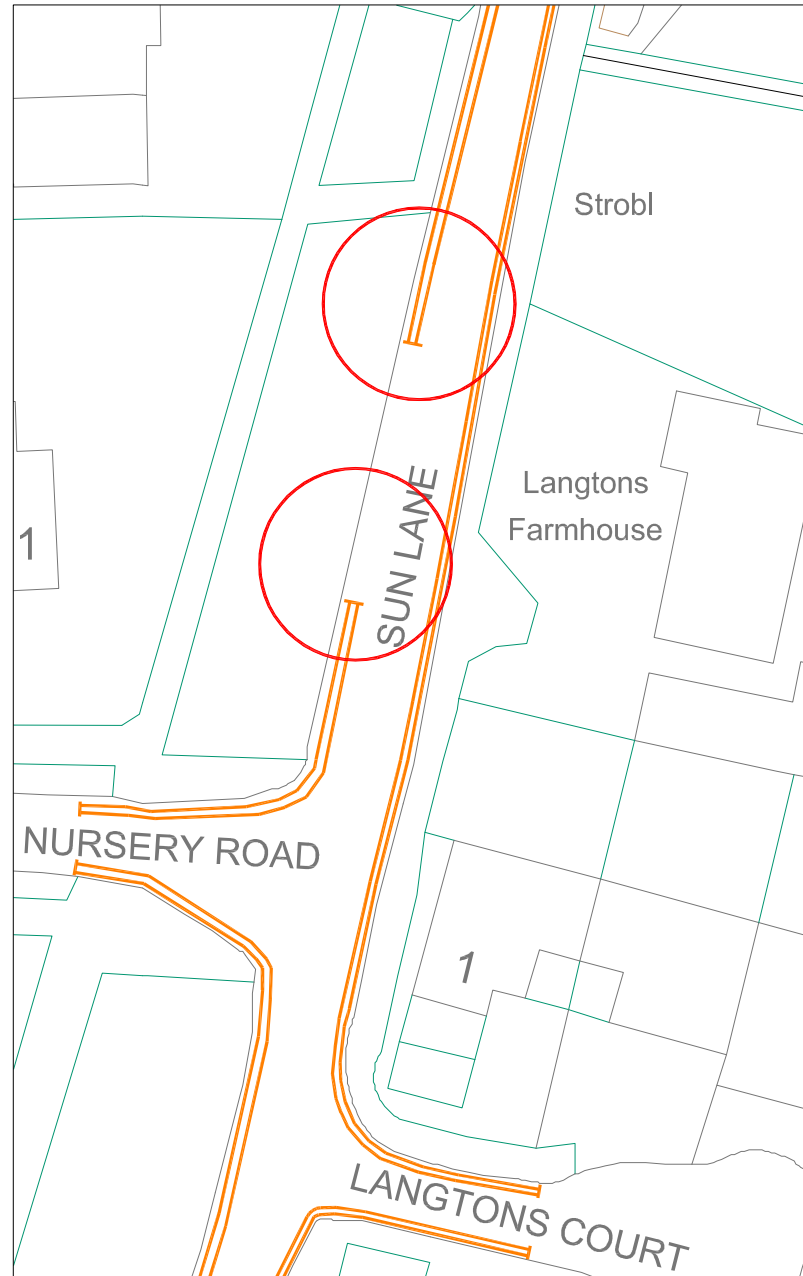

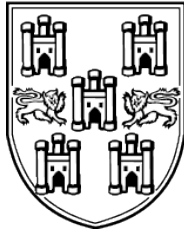
