TOPIC - TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER - LAWN STREET, WINCHESTER

SUMMARY

- This proposal is in response to complaints from blue badge holders that non-badge holders were continually parking in the advisory disabled bay in Lawn Street, Winchester. The only way to prevent this is to make the disabled bay enforceable by including it in the traffic regulation order. It is therefore proposed to make the bay in Lawn Street 'disabled permit holders only'. The loss of this bay to resident permit holders is being mitigated by the introduction of new permit holder bays locally as covered in PHD642.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 29th July 2015. Notices were posted
 on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid
 Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City
 Office reception. No responses were received.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.

- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There are no additional enforcement resource implications.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal is attached (Appendix 1).
- Copy of proposed schedule and statement of reasons is attached (Appendix 2).
- Copy of the proposal notice is attached (Appendix 3).


