SUMMARY

- Changes to the waiting restrictions in Stoney Lane, Winchester were requested by the potential developer of 2 Stoney Lane to facilitate an entrance to the new development in accordance with an outline planning application. The proposal involved removing the '2 hours limited waiting' parking bay and replacing it with 'No waiting 10am to 4pm Monday to Friday' single yellow lines.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 15 July 2015. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City Office reception. No responses were received.

- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded by the developer. There will be no additional enforcement costs.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal is attached (Appendix 1).
- Copy of proposed schedule and statement of reasons is attached (Appendix 2).

Winchester City Council acting on behalf of Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections under Sections 1,2 4,32,35,45,46,49,51 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (" the Act"), as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order :-
