TOPIC – TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – SUN LANE, NEW ALRESFORD

SUMMARY

- In response to requests from Hampshire Constabulary and Alresford Primary School concerning problems caused by inconsiderate parking along Sun Lane in the vicinity of the school it is proposed to introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions at the two junctions of Sun Lane with Sun Hill Crescent and at its junction with Apple Down Close.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 29th July 2015. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City Office reception. Four responses were received, two in support and two objecting to the proposal.
- The two objections both stated that the proposed restrictions do not address wider traffic management issues relating to school traffic and congestion, that the restrictions would displace vehicles into side roads and that the problems should

be addressed by the school through their travel plan rather than the Council imposing restrictions on the road.

- These objections have not been fully resolved, however it has been pointed out that the proposed restrictions are only intended to address the access and visibility problems caused by inconsiderate/illegal parking in the immediate vicinity of the junctions and their extent has been kept to the minimum considered necessary to make the junction safer for all road users. The implementation of the proposed restrictions would not compromise any future wider review which might come out of a school travel plan. The local Members have confirmed their support for the restrictions to be introduced as advertised.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There are not expected to be any additional enforcement requirements and therefore no additional resource implications.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR REVISION:-

On traffic management and road safety grounds to address issues of visibility and obstruction. Parents connected with Sun Hill Infant School are parking on and immediately adjacent to junctions along Sun Lane resulting in reduced visibility and restricting available road space to manoeuvre. The proposed restrictions will keep the junctions clear and reduce the potential conflict.

THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, NEW ALRESFORD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1998 (VARIATION NO.5) ORDER 2015

Winchester City Council acting on behalf of Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections under Sections 1, 2 4,32,35,45,46,49,51 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (" the Act"), as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order :-

 In this order the "Principal Order "means "The Hampshire (Various Roads, New Alresford) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1998 as amended by the "The Hampshire (The Dean Area, New Alresford) (Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2001 and any reference to Principal Order shall be a reference to both of the aforementioned orders.

- 2. The Principal Order shall have effect in that the items in Schedule I to this order shall be inserted into Schedule I Part I of the Principal Order
- 3. This order may be cited as The Hampshire (Various Roads, New Alresford)
 (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1998 (Variation No. 5) Order 2015 shall come into operation on the day of 2015
