<u>TOPIC – TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – CROMWELL ROAD (SERVICE</u> ROAD) WINCHESTER

SUMMARY

- Due to damage caused by large vehicles to the grass area in Cromwell Road, Winchester adjacent to the shops WCC Housing and the local Councillor requested that the parking bays outside 82a Cromwell Road be replaced with yellow lines thereby removing the pinch point caused by parked cars.
- It is therefore being proposed to replace the existing '2 hours limited waiting with permit holders exemption 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday' parking bay with 'No waiting at any time' restrictions.
- The proposed changes were formally advertised on 22nd November 2017. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the city Office reception. In addition to this letters were sent to all residents and businesses in the service road notifying

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them that the proposal was being advertised together with information of how to view the full details. No responses were received to the formal consultation.

- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no additional enforcement resource implications.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal as advertised is attached (Appendix 1).
- Copy of the schedule and statement of reasons as advertised is attached (Appendix 2).

DECISION

- That restrictions be introduced as detailed in the schedule attached (Appendix 2).
- That the Legal Services Manager be authorised to make the necessary order.
