2020

Collected - £622, 118.82 Spent – Admin costs. Projects - none

2021

Collected - £2,352,488.58 Spent - £75,000.00 Projects - Waltham Chase Exception Site

2022

Collected - £1,646,191.96 Spent – Admin costs Projects - none

2023

Collected - £4,572,761.50 Spent - Admin costs Projects – none

The above are Section 106 receipts as there are no affordable housing contributions associated with Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL). The above reflects the fact that Winchester City Council is a local authority that develops its own housing and so has a range of finances that it draws upon and also that the District contains 3 Major Development Areas.
