To lay the pipeline alongside the existing track results in the minimum impact on the area TPO as a whole, allows easy future maintenance from the track and affects mature ash specimens which may succumb to ash dieback which appears to be present in the area. It is technically possible to install a tunnel, but at this pipe diameter this would require a very expensive microtunnel or auger tunnelling technique over 69m in length and taking 14 days tunnelling time, the cost to the bill payer and additional embodied carbon impact of which is not considered justified in this case. Therefore, Southern Water is proposing to install the pipeline through the edge of the copse via an open cut trench.

playing field just outside Otterbourne Water Supply Works. The largest vehicle to access the area via the haul road through the woodland TPO will be a low loader with the TBM (tunnel boring machine) on it, the length is 18.1m. There will be a number of

other deliveries of construction materials such as

concrete, grout, shaft rings, jacking pipes (these will be delivered on rigid 3 or 4 axle lorries. There will also be a number of loads of muckaway (20t tipper vehicles). 5m height clearance from ground level will need to be provided. Levels will be built up with crushed stone to tie in with the existing track. Once

The shading is extreme, and therefore the applicant wishes to fell one yew to the SE of the structure and three holm oaks occupying that northern row nearest the house, whilst retaining some of the southern row for screening from neighbouring properties. There are also two holm oaks to the SW aspect of the structure to be felled as they are both in a severe state of decline with a strong canopy bias over the neighbouring properties.

Although appearing extreme, these trees aren't particularly visible from anywhere other than the garden of 5 Sleepers hill gardens, so removing this N aspect row will enable the occupants of Thurmond crescent to still enjoy the amenity of the S facing row,

whilst alleviating the shading for the applicant.
