

WHAT TO PUT IN THE **GREEN** **MIXED RECYCLING BINS**

Remember the golden rule... all recycling placed in the recycling bin needs to be **CLEAN, DRY** and **LOOSE!**

YES PLEASE!



PAPER

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Junk mail
- Computer paper
- Envelopes, including windowed envelopes
- Catalogues and directories
- Paper bags
- Greetings cards

CARDBOARD

- Cereal packets
- Food boxes
- Greetings cards
- Kitchen and toilet roll holders
- Egg boxes
- Corrugated card

PLASTIC BOTTLES

- Food and drink bottles e.g. milk and drink bottles, shampoo bottles and cleaning product bottles. Lids and labels can be left on. Please empty any liquid content and squash the bottle before replacing the lid.
- Detergent bottles e.g. washing up liquid, cleaning fluids, bleach and fabric softener
- Toiletries e.g. shampoo, shower gel and liquid soap

TINS AND CANS

- Food tins including pet food tins
- Drink cans
- Sweet and biscuit tins

AEROSOLS

- Food e.g. cream and oil
- Deodorant
- Hairspray

PAPER

- Shredded paper
- Gift wrap
- Plastic coated (laminated) paper
- Paper towels, tissues and napkins
- Wall paper

AEROSOLS

- Lids
- Full or partially full aerosol

CARDBOARD

- Any plastic or foam packaging left inside cardboard boxes – please dispose of this in the black general refuse bin
- Pizza boxes, due to food debris

PLASTIC BOTTLES

- Bottles containing liquid or bottles that are not empty
- Spray and pump dispensers
- Food and drinks cartons (such as Tetra Pak)
- Plastic carrier bags or sacks
- Plastic pots, tubs, trays or cartons

TINS AND CANS

- Paint tins
- Partially full food / pet food tins or dirty tins
- Other metals (including Aluminium foil) or metal packaging

OTHER

- Textiles, clothes and shoes
- Polystyrene
- Batteries

WHAT TO PUT IN THE **MIXED GLASS,** **BOTTLES AND JARS BINS**

GLASS BOTTLES

- such as wine, beer, cooking oil and perfume

GLASS JARS

- including clear and coloured glass

- Lids, corks or tops
- Spectacles
- Vases
- Light bulbs and tubes
- Cookware
- Crockery
- Nail varnish bottles
- Mirrors, sheet glass and windowpanes



THINGS THAT MUST **NOT** GO IN THE **BLACK GENERAL WASTE BINS**

- Stones or brick rubble
- DIY material
- Paint / chemicals or oil
- Hot ashes
- Clinical waste (we provide a free domestic service for this)
- Commercial, trade or industrial waste
- Scrap metal
- Poisonous or noxious waste
- Garden waste
- Electrical products
- Batteries, including disposable and rechargeable vapes with batteries

You can dispose of some of these items at your local Household Recycling Centres.
