<u>Upham Village Design Statement (VDS) Adoption Statement</u>

A Village Design Statement (VDS) has been produced for the settlements of Upham and Lower Upham and their immediate surroundings (within Upham Parish) which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the area will be assessed. The area covered by the Upham VDS is shown in the map below

Winchester City Council adopted the Upham VDS as a Supplementary Planning Document to the Winchester District Local Plan on 20 March 2025 following a public consultation between 11th November – 23rd December 2024. Modifications made following the consultation can be found in the report to the Cabinet Member for the Built Environment Decision Day meeting on 20 March 2025 (DD83).

Report DD83 represents the Council's regulation 12a statement of public consultation, setting out the persons consulted on the draft VDS, a summary of the main issues raised and how those issues have been addressed in the final VDS.

This adoption statement refers only to the part of the area within the Winchester District as shown in the Map below.
