

Winchester City Council has received an application from Marks And Spencer Plc Waterside House 35 North Wharf Road London W2 1NW for a Minor Variation for Marks And Spencer, Whiteley Shopping Centre, Whiteley Way, Whiteley, Fareham Hampshire.

The purpose of the application is to amend the licenced plan, changes taking place to the tills on the ground and first floor.

**Representations from Responsible Authorities or any other person must be received at Winchester City Council offices no later than 5 August 2024.**

Only written representations that relate to one or more of the four licensing objectives can be considered. The licensing objectives are:

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- Public safety
- The prevention of public nuisance
- The protection of children from harm

Representations must clearly set out the likely effects the variation of the licence would have on the promotion of at least one of the licensing objectives, and must clearly relate to the premises for which application is being made.

The Act requires the Council to disregard representations that are considered to be frivolous or vexatious or repetitive.
