

Winchester City Council has received an application from Shell UK Oil Products Limited, Shell Centre, London, SE1 7NA for a Minor Variation for Shell, Sutton Scotney Services Southbound, A34, Sutton Scotney, Winchester Hampshire.

The purpose of the application is to add conditions to annex two of the premises licence as detailed below:-

- 1. The premises licence holder will require any third-party delivery partner delivering on behalf of the premises licence holder to comply with all legal requirements pertaining to the retail sale of alcohol, and in particular to operate a Challenge 25 age verification policy.
- 2. The premises licence holder will require all third-party delivery partners not to deliver alcohol to schools, parks or playgrounds.

Representations from Responsible Authorities or any other person must be received at Winchester City Council offices no later than 3 February 2025.

Only written representations that relate to one or more of the four licensing objectives can be considered. The licensing objectives are:

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- Public safety
- The prevention of public nuisance
- The protection of children from harm

Representations must clearly set out the likely effects the variation of the licence would have on the promotion of at least one of the licensing objectives and must clearly relate to the premises for which application is being made.

The Act requires the Council to disregard representations that are considered to be frivolous or vexatious or repetitive.

Please note that relevant representations will form part of a public document which will include your name and address and will appear on this website. Anonymous representations will be disregarded.
