WAITING RESTRICTIONS – CHURCH ROAD AND NEW ROAD, SWANMORE

TAKE NOTICE that on 16th November 2006 Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council made an experimental traffic regulation order as follows :-

EFFECT OF ORDER:

1. To introduce “No waiting Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm” waiting restrictions in Church Road, Swanmore from a point 60.0 metres north-west of its junction with New Road to a point 30.0 metres south-east of that junction.
2. To introduce “No waiting Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm” waiting restrictions in New Road, Swanmore from its junction with Church Road to a point 40.0 metres south-west of that junction.

IMPLEMENTATION:

The Order will come into effect on 30th November 2006.

The Order is to be on an experimental basis for a maximum period of 18 months and the Council will, in due course consider whether the provisions of the Order should continue in force indefinitely.

OBJECTIONS: Within a period of six months from when the experimental Order comes into force or, if the Order is subsequently varied or modified within six months of the date of the coming into force of such variation or modification any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.

All objections must be in writing, stating the grounds on which they are made and sent to the undersigned.
