TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CLIFTON ROAD, WINCHESTER.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for footway resurfacing works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED:

CLIFTON ROAD, WINCHESTER from its junction with St Pauls Hill to its junction with North View.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the south-western point of the closure south via Clifton Road, east via Romsey Road, north via Clifton Terrace, north-west via St Pauls Hill **to the north-eastern point of the closure.**

From the north-eastern point of the closure south-east via St Pauls Hill, south via Clifton Terrace, west via Romsey Road, north via Clifton Road **to the south-western point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED:

None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From and including the 2nd November 2006 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above the closure is only likely to be for 1 week)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
