TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – EAST HOE ROAD, HAMBLEDON.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order to allow for carriageway patching works to be carried out as follows:-

ROAD TO BE CLOSED – EAST HOE ROAD, HAMBLEDON between its junction with Green Lane (B2150) and its junction with Hoe Street/Hambledon Lane/Cams Hill.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the northern point of the closure south-east via Green Lane (B2150), and then west via Cams Hill **to the southern point of the closure.**

From the southern point of the closure east via Cams Hill, and then north-east via Green Lane (B2150) **to the northern point of the closure.**

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 16th April 2007 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 5 days)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
