TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – SPARKFORD ROAD, WINCHESTER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order to allow for various works connected to new development works to be carried out as follows:-

ROAD TO BE CLOSED – SPARKFORD ROAD, WINCHESTER between its junction with St James' Lane and its junction with Airlie Road.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the northern point of the closure south-east via St James' Lane, south via St Cross Road, west via Ranelagh Road/Airlie Road **to the southern point of the closure.**

From the southern point of the closure south-east via Airlie Road/Ranlegh Road, north via St Cross Road, west via St James' Lane **to the northern point of the closure.**

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 8th May 2007 for a period of six months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 6 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
