Regulation 19 – Adoption Statement regarding Supplementary Planning Document

Kings Worthy and Abbots Worthy Village Design Statement (VDS)

Winchester City Council has adopted a Village Design Statement for Kings Worthy and Abbots Worthy, Winchester produced by the local community, which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the area will be assessed.

The Kings Worthy and Abbots Worthy VDS is a Supplementary Planning Document that supplements the Winchester District Local Plan Review (WDLPR 2006) and, in due course, the emerging Winchester District Local Development Framework (WDLDF).

The document was adopted as supplementary to the Winchester District Local Plan Review by the Council on 08 February 2007, following the consultation period held in the spring of 2006.

The VDS incorporates within it a Statement of Public Consultation, which appears as Appendix 1 to the VDS, and fulfils the requirements of Regulation 18(4)(b) of the above regulations.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Kings Worthy and Abbots Worthy VDS may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the Council's decision to adopt it. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date of this notice.
