TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – GRANGE ROAD, ALRESFORD.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for drainage works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED:

GRANGE ROAD, ALRESFORD from a point 20 metres west of its junction with Rosebery Road to a point 20 metres east of that junction.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the western point of the closure west via Grange Road, west via South Road, south-east via New Farm Road, east via Spring Gardens, north-east via Jacklyns Lane, west via Grange Road **to the eastern point of the closure.**

From the eastern point of the closure east via Grange Road, south-west via Jacklyns Lane, west via Spring Gardens, north-west via New Farm Road, east via South Road, east via Grange Road **to the western point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED:

None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From and including the 5th April 2007 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above the closure is only likely to be for 2 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
