

**Notice of Proposals of making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders  
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council**

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes making the undermentioned road traffic regulation orders:-

**1. "The Hampshire (Various Roads Bishop's Waltham) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2004 (Variation No.1) Order 2008**

The effect of this order will be to introduce an enforceable disabled parking bay. Details are as follows:-

Disabled Permit Holders only

**2. The Hampshire (Various Roads, Denmead) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2008.**

The effect of this order will be to introduce waiting restrictions in Denmead. Details are as follows:-
