(PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING)  
(CONTROLLED ZONE) ORDER 2002 (VARIATION NO.41) ORDER 2007

On 15<sup>th</sup> February 2008, Winchester City Council made a road traffic regulation order as follows:

EFFECT OF ORDER: To introduce no waiting restriction areas in St Thomas Street. Details of the areas affected are as under.

APPLICATION TO THE HIGH COURT:

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
