TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – WHARF HILL WINCHESTER.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for gas works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED: WHARF HILL from its junction with Chesil Street for its entire length.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the northern point of closure south via Chesil Street/Bar End Road, west via Garnier Road, north via Kingsgate Street, east via College Street, **to the southern point of the closure.**

From the southern point of the closure west via College Street, south via Kingsgate Street, east via Garnier Road, north via Bar End Road/Chesil Street **to the northern point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: Prohibition of motor vehicles in College Street.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 10th August 2008 for three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 5 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
