

Notice of Making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council

On 6th May 2008 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation orders:-

THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, DENMEAD) (PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2008

The effect of this order which was advertised on the 14th February 2008 is to introduce no waiting at any time zones in Denmead. Details are as follows:-

No Waiting at Any Time

<i>NAME OF ROAD</i>	<i>SIDE</i>	<i>DESCRIPTION</i>
BERE ROAD	BOTH	FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH HAMBLEDON ROAD (B2150) TO A POINT 20.0 METRES SOUTH-WEST OF THAT JUNCTION.
HILDA GARDENS	BOTH	FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH BERE ROAD TO A POINT 10.0 METRES SOUTH-EAST OF THAT JUNCTION.
MARTIN AVENUE	BOTH	FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH HAMBLEDON ROAD (B2150) TO A POINT 15.0 METRES NORTH-EAST OF THAT JUNCTION.
THE HEATH	BOTH	FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH HAMBLEDON ROAD FOR A DISTANCE OF 20.0 METRES SOUTH-WEST OF THAT JUNCTION

The Order will come into operation on **15th May 2008**

Copies of the orders, maps showing the locations and a statement of reasons for each of the above orders and the orders to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
