TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – KILN LANE, BRAMBRIDGE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for bridge repair works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED: KILN LANE from its junction with Brambridge Park Garden Centre to its junction with Otterbourne Hill.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the eastern point of closure east via Kiln Lane, southwest via Highbridge Road (B3335), west via Allbrook Hill, north via Allbrook Way (A335), northeast Via Otterbourne Hill **to the western point of the closure.**

From the western point of the closure southwest via Otterbourne Hill, south via Allbrook Way (A335), east via Allbrook Hill, northeast via Highbridge Road (B3335), west via Kiln Lane **to the eastern point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 6th July 2009 for six months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 5 days)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
