TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – HIGH STREET, WINCHESTER.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order to allow for highway maintenance works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED:

HIGH STREET, WINCHESTER from its junction with Southgate Street to its junction with Romsey Road/Upper High Street.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the eastern point of the closure west via High Street, north via Jewry Street, west via City Road, south via Sussex Street, south-east via Upper High Street **to the western point of the closure.**

Access to Tower Road/Tower Street/Cross Street/Staple Gardens.

From the western point of the closure north-west via Upper High Street, east via Gladstone Street, south via Sussex Street.

ORDERS TO BE REVOKED:

One way traffic orders in Tower Street and Tower Road to be revoked.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

This order is enforceable on the 21st June 2009 for a period of 3 months or until the completion of the works whichever is sooner.

(notwithstanding the above the closure is expected to be for one Sunday only).

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
