Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Council's Licensing and Regulation Committee intend to pass a resolution under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 4 of the above Act at its meeting of 28 March 2011.

The terms of the draft resolution are as follows:-

"That the following streets be designated as consent streets under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982:-

Middle Brook Street between High Street to North Walls	High Street between Westgate and City Bridge (including "The Broadway")	Market Street
Market Lane	Paternoster Row	The Square
St. Clements Street	Minster Lane	St. Thomas Street
Simonds Street	St Swithuns Street between Simonds Street and Kingsgate Street	College Street
Great Minster Street	Parchment Street for a distance of 137 metres (150 yards) from High Street	All other roads joining High Street for a distance of 46 metres (50 yards) from High Street
Friarsgate from junction with Eastgate Street to its junction with Upper Brook Street	Upper Brook Street from its junction with High Street to its junction with North Walls	St Georges Street from its junction with Middle Brook Street to its junction with Jewry Street
Tanner Street and Silver Hill	Jewry Street	Little Minster Street

ALRESFORD

East Street	West Street	Ladywell Lane
The Dean	Station Road	Station Car Park

Station Approach	Jacklyns Lane (between West Street and the Railway Arch)	Pound Hill
Winchester Road	Mill Hill	The Soke

Once made, the resolution will allow the City Council to control street trading in these streets, using powers set out in the 1982 Act.
