

THE HAMPSHIRE (HYDE CHURCH LANE,WINCHESTER)
(EXPERIMENTAL NO ENTRY) ORDER 2011

TAKE NOTICE that on 28th June 2011 Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council made an experimental traffic regulation order as follows :-

EFFECT OF ORDER:

1. To introduce "No entry any time" in the following roads:-

EXPERIMENTAL NO ENTRY

<u>Road Name</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Zone</u> *
HYDE CHURCH LANE	NO MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER HYDE CHURCH LANE FROM WORTHY LANE	

IMPLEMENTATION: The Order will come into effect on 6th July 2011
The Order is to be on an experimental basis for a maximum period of 12 months and the Council will, in due course consider whether the provisions of the Order should continue in force indefinitely.

OBJECTIONS: Within a period of six months from when the experimental Order comes into force or, if the Order is subsequently varied or modified within six months of the date of the coming into force of such variation or modification any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.

All objections must be in writing, stating the grounds on which they are made and sent to the undersigned.

FURTHER DETAILS: A copy of this notice, the order, a map showing the location and effect of the order and a statement of reasons may be inspected during usual hours at City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester, Hampshire.
