

**Notice of Making of Traffic Regulation Order**  
**Affecting the District of Winchester City Council**

On 16<sup>th</sup> September 2011 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation order:-

THE HAMPSHIRE (WINCHESTER TOWN CENTRE, VARIOUS ROADS)  
(TEMPORARY 20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011

The effect of this order proposals for which were advertised on the 13<sup>th</sup> July 2011 will be limit the speed of vehicles to a maximum of 20 miles per hour in various roads in Winchester. . Details are as follows:-

**Road to be subject to 20mph Speed limit**

**Roads in the District of Winchester**  
**20 mph Speed Limit**

- (i) Colebrook Street, for its entirety
- (ii) Market Lane, for its entirety
- (iii) The Square, for its entirety
- (iv) Great Minister Street, for its entirety
- (v) Little Minster Street, for its entirety
- (vi) Minster Lane, for its entirety
- (vii) Kings Head Yard, for its entirety
- (viii) St Thomas Street, for its entirety
- (ix) Symonds Street, for its entirety
- (x) St Swithun Street, for its entirety
- (xi) St Clement Street, from its junction with Southgate Street to its junction with Little Minister Street.
- (xii) Market Street, from its junction with Market Lane to its junction with The Square.

the above order will come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> November 2011

A copy of the order, map showing the location and a statement of reasons for the above order and the order to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
