TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ST PETER STREET, WINCHESTER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for water main/connection works and highway works to be carried out as follows:-

ROAD TO BE CLOSED: ST PETER STREET, WINCHESTER between its junction with Sutton Gardens and its junction with Albion Place.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE:

From the southern point of closure south via St Peter Street, west via St Georges Street, north via Jewry Street, east via North Walls, south via St Peter Street **to the northern point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: One-way traffic order in St Peter Street to be suspended to allow for access.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 26th September 2011 for three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 2 days)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
