Regulation 19 – Adoption Statement regarding Supplementary Planning Document

St Giles Hill Neighbourhood Design Statement (NDS)

Winchester City Council and St Giles Hill Residents Association have produced a revised Neighbourhood Design Statement (NDS) for the St Giles Hill area of Winchester which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the area will be assessed.

Winchester City Council adopted the revised St Giles Hill NDS as a Supplementary Planning Document to the Winchester District Local Plan Review (WDLPR 2006) on 28 September 2011 following the public consultation period held earlier in 2011. The revised NDS incorporates within it a statement of public consultation, which outlines how the public was involved in the consultation on this document.
