TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – WHITE’S HILL, OWSLEBURY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for BT works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED: WHITE’S HILL, OWSLEBURY between its junction with Hatchers Lane and a point 200 yards west of Boyes Farm.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES: **From the southern point of closure** east via Main Road, north-west via Owslebury Bottom, west via Hackers Lane **to the northern point of the closure.**

From the northern point of closure north-east via Hackers Lane, south via Owslebury Bottom, south-west via Main Road **to the southern point of closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 19th March 2012 for three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 5 days)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
