

Notice of Making of Traffic Regulation Order
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council

On 18th September 2012 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation order:-

The Hampshire (Various Roads Winchester) (Parking Places And Restriction Of Waiting) (Controlled Zone) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (Variation No. 6) Order 2012

The effect of this order proposals for which were advertised on the 2nd May 2012 will change resident's discounts for parking permits for holders using low emission vehicles. Details are as follows:-

A discount for the appropriate fee as specified in the Order for the first permit issued shall be made for Vehicles with CO₂ emissions as follows;

Electric vehicles or vehicles with emissions of 75g/km or less – 75% discount

Emissions from and including 76-90 g/km – 50%

All current resident permit holders will be granted an additional years renewal at the current discounted price to allow time to adjust to the proposed changes

the above order will come into operation on the 21st September 2012

A copy of the order, map showing the location and a statement of reasons for the above order and the order to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
