

**Notice of Proposals of making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes making the undermentioned road traffic regulation orders:-

**1. The Hampshire (Various Roads Winchester) (Parking Places And Restriction Of Waiting) (Controlled Zone) (No.2) Order (Variation No.1) 2012**

The effect of this order will be to introduce the following restrictions in Stanmore Winchester:-

**2. The Hampshire (Various Roads, Littleton and Harestock) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 2012."**

The effect of this order will be to introduce the following restrictions in Littleton and Harestock:-

Bradley Road	Littleton & Harestock	No Waiting At Any Time (Double Yellow Lines)

**3. The Hampshire (Various Roads, Kings Worthy) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 2009 (Variation No.1) 2012**

The effect of this order will be to introduce the following restrictions in Kings Worthy:-

<b>Road Name</b>	<b>Parish</b>	<b>Traffic Restrictions Proposed</b>
North Road	Kings Worthy	Reduction of No Waiting At Any Time
