

**Notice of Making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders  
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council**

On 19<sup>th</sup> March 2013 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation orders:-

**1. The Hampshire (Various Roads Winchester) (Parking Places And Restriction Of Waiting) (Controlled Zone) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (Variation No. 15) Order 2012**

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2012 will be to extend no waiting provisions in Bereweke Road, Winchester. Details are as follows:-

The above order will come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013

**2. The Hampshire (Micheldever Station) (Width Restriction) Order 1973 (Variation No.1) Order 2012**

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2012 will be to introduce weight and width restrictions in Andover Road Micheldever. Details are as follows:-

Andover Road from its junction with Overton Road to a point 120.0 metres north west of that junction will be subject to a 7.5 tonne maximum weight (Gross) and a width limit of 6 feet 6 inches (2.0 metres)

The above order will come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013

**3. The Hampshire (Various Roads Compton and Shawford) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2006 (Variation No. 2) Order 2012**

The effect of this order details of which were advertised on the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2012 will be to extend waiting provisions in Shawford Road Shawford and to introduce waiting in the Hockley Link lay-bys . Details are as follows:-

HOCKLEY LINK	NORTH	BETWEEN A POINT 186.0 METRES WEST OF THE JUNCTION OF THE A3090 AND B3335 WINCHESTER ROAD AND A POINT 293.1 METRES WEST OF THAT JUNCTION.
HOCKLEY LINK	EAST	BETWEEN A POINT 40.0 METRES NORTH OF THE JUNCTION WITH THE SOUTH WINCHESTER PARK & RIDE ROUNDABOUT AND A POINT 144.4 METRES NORTH OF THAT ROUNDABOUT.
HOCKLEY LINK	WEST	BETWEEN A POINT 40.0 METRES NORTH OF THE JUNCTION WITH THE SOUTH WINCHESTER PARK & RIDE ROUNDABOUT AND A POINT 118.7 METRES NORTH OF THAT ROUNDABOUT.

The above order will come into operation on the 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2013

Copies of the orders, maps showing the locations and a statement of reasons for each of the above orders and the orders to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
