

**Notice of Making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders**

**1. The Hampshire (Various Roads, Winchester) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) (controlled Zone) (No.2) Order 2012 (Variation No. 5) Order 2014**

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2013 will be to amend the no waiting area and introduce Echelon 2 hour limited waiting with permit holder exemptions in an off road parking area at 114 -143 Cromwell Road, Winchester.

**9. The Hampshire (Various Roads, Wonston and Micheldever) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2010 (Variation No. 2) Order 2013**

The effect of this order proposals for which were advertised on the 11<sup>th</sup> December 2013 will be to introduce no stopping provisions on the entrance to the School in Downs Road, South Wonston. Details are as follows:-

Copies of the orders, maps showing the locations and a statement of reasons for each of the above orders and the orders to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
