

**Notice of Making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council**

On 15th September 2014 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation order:-

1. The Hampshire (Various Roads Colden Common) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2006 (Variation No. 3) Order 2014

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 2nd July 2014 will be to introduce no waiting provisions in Colden Common. Details are as follows:-

SPRING LANE	COLDEN COMMON & TWYFORD	NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES) LOCATED AT JUNCTION WITH MINI ROUNDABOUT, UPPER MOORS ROAD, LOWER MOORS ROAD AND HILL LANE.
LOWER MOORS ROAD	COLDEN COMMON & TWYFORD	NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES) LOCATED NEAR SPRING LANE JUNCTION.
UPPER MOORS ROAD	COLDEN COMMON & TWYFORD	NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES) LOCATED NEAR SPRING LANE JUNCTION.
HILL LANE	COLDEN COMMON & TWYFORD	NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES) LOCATED NEAR SPRING LANE JUNCTION.

On 15th September 2014 Winchester City Council made the undermentioned Road Traffic Regulation Order

2. The Winchester City (Off Street) Parking Places Order 2003 (Variation No.8) Order 2013

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 16th October 2013 will be to introduce 4 Hour limited waiting in Garnier Road Car park with no return within 8 hours.

Each of the above orders will come into operation on 20th October 2014
Copies of the orders, maps showing the locations and a statement of reasons for each of the above orders and the orders to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
