



NOTICE OF MAKING DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4 OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995

NOTICE IS GIVEN that Winchester City Council ("the Council") has made a Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, as amended, in relation to land comprised in the Stanmore Estate, Winchester, Hampshire ("the Land").

The Direction relates to development of the type specified in the Schedule to this Notice within the area specified above.

The effect of the Direction is that permission granted by article 3 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, shall not apply to development of the type specified in the Schedule to this Notice and that such development shall not be carried out on the Land unless planning permission is granted by the Council on an application made to the Council.

The Direction was made by the Council on 2 March 2015 and will come into force on 11 April 2016.

SCHEDULE

Development consisting of a change of the use of a building to a use falling within Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 from a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of that Schedule, being development comprised within Class I (b) of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other class.
