Shedfield Village Design Statement (VDS)

A Village Design Statements (VDS) has been produced for the Parish of Shedfield which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the Parish will be assessed.

Winchester City Council adopted the Shedfield VDS as a Supplementary Planning Document to the Winchester District Local Plan on 29 February 2016 following a public consultation period in 2015. The VDS incorporates within it a statement of public consultation, which outlines how the public was involved in the consultation.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Shedfield VDS may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the Council's decision to adopt it. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date of this notice.
