

TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Notice of making of Road Traffic Regulation Order Affecting the District of Winchester City Council

On 26th September 2016 Winchester City Council and Winchester City Council acting as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation order:-

The Hampshire (Various Roads, Winchester) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) (No.2) Order 2002 (Variation No. 37) Order 2015

The effect of this order proposals for which were advertised on the 15th July 2015 will be to remove parking bays in Stoney Lane and extend the no waiting provisions. Details are as follows:-

The above order will come into operation on 1st October 2016.

Copies of the order, map showing the location and a statement of reason for the above order and the order to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above order or any of the provisions of the order on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the order was made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
