



TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Notice of making of Road Traffic Regulation Order
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council

On 26th September 2016 Winchester City Council and Winchester City Council acting as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation order:

The Hampshire (Various Roads Swanmore and Newtown) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2016

The effect of this order is to incorporate provisions that are already in force by virtue of the Hampshire (Various Roads, Swanmore) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 2008 and proposals for no waiting areas which were advertised on the 18th May 2016 (the majority of the provisions which were advertised on the 16th May are not being implemented) Details are as follows;

CHURCH ROAD	SWANMORE	SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS

The above orders will come into operation on 1st October 2016

Copies of the orders, maps showing the locations and a statement of reasons for the above order and the order to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the above order or any of the provisions of the order on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
