



## NOTICE OF PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

### THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, WONSTON AND MICHELDEVER) (PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2010 (VARIATION NO. 5) ORDER 2019

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers. If the Order comes into force it will introduce the following changes:

1. To make the junction of Taylors Yard and Oxford Road subject to 'no waiting' restrictions (double yellow lines) in order to address reduced visibility at the junction caused by vehicles parking on the corners.
